



DAVE'S DISPATCH

This current policy year, which runs from October 1-September 30 yearly, we have opened 30 new claims. At this rate, we will only have an estimated 45-50 new claim files which will translate into by far the lowest new claim file count we've seen.

We are seeing litigants discontinuing their lawsuits at an elevated rate. This means we close the claim file. We attribute this to the current economic climate and the expense of pursuing litigation.

Events have more than doubled this year compared to figures from the corresponding period last year and are on track to reflect what we have seen during uptick market periods.

We are having an excellent year on recoveries in that so far, we have recovered \$131,760 with more coming.

At present we have 163 open files.
